

Jewelry Box & Organizer Size Reference

Typical inner dimensions for rings, necklaces, earrings, travel cases & watch rolls

How to read this sheet

Figures are **inner usable dimensions** (length × width × height, or diameter for round boxes), the space the jewelry actually sits in. Outer dimensions run 3–10 mm larger per side once walls, lid and padding are added. Use these as a starting point when briefing a factory or checking a sample against your piece.

Single-piece boxes

Box type	Inner (L×W×H mm)	Fits
Ring box	45×51×38	1 ring on a insert pad or single slot
Pendant / necklace box	80×65×38	1 pendant on a card up to 70 mm drop
Earring card box	60×60×35	1 pair on a 50×50 mm card
Bracelet box	95×70×38	1 bangle / cuff up to 80 mm inner
Small jewelry box	100×100×55	rings + a few studs, no chain
Watch box (single)	95×95×65	1 watch on a 70 mm cushion

Travel & multi-compartment organizers

Organizer type	Closed (L×W×H mm)	Capacity
Travel jewelry case	100×100×50	rings + earrings + 1 necklace, zip
Watch roll	Ø65 (rolled) ×100	2–3 watch cushions + 1 pocket
Jewelry roll (soft)	240×120 (open)	rings, studs, 1 chain, snap
Multi-compartment box	180×130×60	rings + earrings + necklaces + watch
Stackable display case	200×150×45	4–6 trays, modular

Measuring a piece before you choose a box

- Longest drop:** pendant length from bail to bottom, lying flat. The box card must exceed it by ~10 mm.
- Chain length:** lay the chain straight; a travel case channel suits up to ~460 mm, a wrapped keepers suits longer.
- Widest point:** a cuff or signet needs the inner width of the bracelet box, not the outer.
- Height:** add ~8 mm for padding under a ring insert or earring pad so the lid closes without pressure.

Material notes that change the size

Velvet and foam inserts add 2–4 mm per side; a PU or leatherette shell adds 1–2 mm. A **window** lid needs a rigid frame, adding ~3 mm to height. For OEM/ODM, send the actual jewelry (or a 3D scan) so the factory tunes the cavity rather than scaling from these averages.
